GENERAL INFORMATION

The President of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Nursultan Nazarbayev, established The Kazakhstan Institute of Management, Economics and Strategic Research on January 14, 1992.

The Kazakhstan Institute of Management, Economics and Strategic Research (KIMEP) was granted university status on January 26, 2012, and became officially known as JSC "KIMEP University", since July 2, 2019, the title of JSC "KIMEP University" was changed to NJSC "KIMEP University" (hereinafter KIMEP University). KIMEP University is staffed by a mixture of foreign and national faculty, and operates according to the high academic standards of North American and European academic systems. Moreover, KIMEP University is one of the few Institutions in the CIS to employ a North American credit system as a foundation of its educational programs. This is also to certify that English is the official language of instruction and the medium of assessment at KIMEP University.

KIMEP University has been institutionally re-accredited by Foundation for International Business Administration Accreditation (FIBAA) until June 4, 2033. Grade below "B-" for postgraduate students will be considered as failing.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

A student's GPA is calculated by dividing the total Credit-Hour Value for a period by the sum of attempted credits in this period for all courses receiving a grade used in calculating the GPA (see above).

REPEATED COURSES

All grades received for all retakes of a course will appear on a student transcript, but only the most recent grade is used in the GPA.

AWARDS AND HONORS

All awards and honors applies to both Graduate and Undergraduate students only based on following criteria:

DEAN'S LIST: Students who are enrolled in 12 (undergraduate students) or 9 (graduate students) or more credits during a semester with semester GPA of 3.75 or higher are placed on it.

PRESIDENT'S LIST: Students who are enrolled in 12 (undergraduate students) or 9 (graduate students) or more credits during a semester with semester GPA of 4.00 or higher are placed on it.

DIPLOMA CUM LAUDE: Overall GPA at graduation is 4.00 or higher

DIPLOMA MAGNA CUM LAUDE: Overall GPA at graduation is 4.15 or higher

DIPLOMA SUMMA CUM LAUDE: Overall GPA at graduation is 4.25 or higher
